Thursday, February 8th 10 – Noon



Thoughts on Stewardship by Pam Sherman

Stewardship is living the vows we took when we joined the church; we promised to support the church with our prayers, our presence, our gifts, our service, and our witness. This month I'd like to focus on service.

Service is the work we do for the church. There are many different ways to serve the church but there is one action that



Someone with long term health issues or someone who is grieving may appreciate hearing from you weeks or months after appearing on the prayer list, so don't feel like it's too late to contact them. Several times over the years I have sent a card to someone 6 or more months after I meant, but failed, to contact them; then I received a reply stating something like "I was feeling particularly low today and then I received your card. It was just what I needed today, so thanks."

Reaching out to someone may seem trivial, but it's not. It may not only make a difference in someone else's life, but may also spur you to serve in greater ways. Give it a try this month.

Revised Common Lectionary

During his sermon on January 21st, Pastor Chris talked about the Revised Common Lectionary, telling us that the lectionary is the order of Bible readings used on particular days of the year. Each lectionary day consists of an Old Testament reading, a Psalm, a Gospel reading, and an Epistle (letter). The Revised Common Lectionary was created by multiple denominations and is based on the Catholic lectionary. There are 3 years in the lectionary (A, B, and C), and so every three years the scripture readings are repeated. United Methodist preachers are encouraged, but not required, to use readings from the lectionary. Pastor Chris choses scripture readings from the Revised Common Lectionary sometimes, but not always.

The lectionary year begins the first week of Advent, so Year B began on December 3, 2023. The next time you look at your Sunday morning bulletin, look for the year at the top of the bulletin. It is located on the same line as the date.
