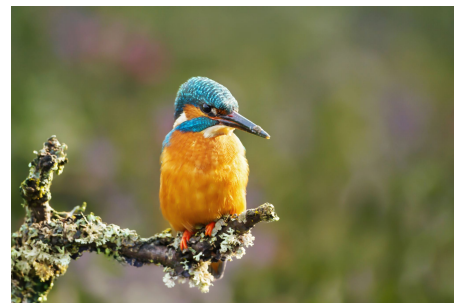

Thoughts on Stewardship by Pam Sherman

Stewardship is living the vows we took when we joined the church; we promised to support the church with our prayers, our presence, our gifts, our service, and our witness. This month I'd like to focus on gifts.

If you read or listen to the news in early April, you will be informed of two events: the Boston Marathon and the deadline to file your annual taxes. Have you filed your taxes yet? If so, will you be receiving a refund from the state or the IRS (or both)? If so, consider tithing 10% of your income tax refund to the church. Receiving a tax refund can feel like a bonus, so it may be easier to tithe than your regular income.

As a reminder, to determine 10% of your refund, multiply your refund by .10. So, for example, if your refund is \$856 then your tithe would be \$85.60 ($856 \times .10$).

If you do decide to tithe your tax refund, let the church know by writing "tax refund tithe" in the memo section of your check. Then enjoy watching the Boston Marathon.
